Apart of course from Polio Eradication, Matching Grants, Ambassadorial Scholarships and Group Study Exchange. Apart from helping clubs finance local projects through **District Simplified Grants** – in the past 7 years, over **2,700 grants** have been awarded at a cost to Foundation of **US\$43 million**. Apart of course from sponsoring the **Rotary Peace Fellowships** to promote skills in peace and conflict resolution – since 2002, more than 480 fellows from 80 countries have completed the 2-year masters degree. " O K ! OK! OK! I get the message. And what do they want in exchange? - **Clubs to donate at least the equivalent of US\$100 per member per year to Foundation funds** to enable this inactivity to continue. Northcliff Rotary manages to maintain its level of donations by its annual levy on all our members and through a few of our members giving individually through the Sustaining Member initiative.

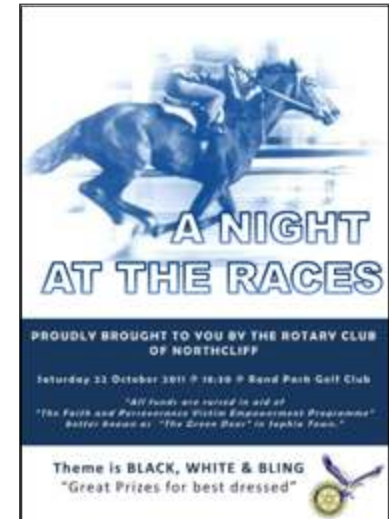


Poppy Day
