TKZee is a South Africa kwaito music group formed by three school friends, Tokollo Tshabalala, Kabelo Mabalane, and Zwai Bala. The group shot to prominence in early 1998 with their hit single *Palafala*. The group's next big release was in the run-up to the 1998 Soccer World Cup, where in collaboration with Bafana Bafana striker Benni McCarthy, the group produced *Shibobo* in June 1998. They quickly became household names not just in South Africa but across the continent. Their third album, *Halloween*, went Platinum, earning them South African Music Awards awards for Best Kwaito Album and Best Kwaito Single. They also performed at the opening ceremony of the 2010 FIFA World Cup.

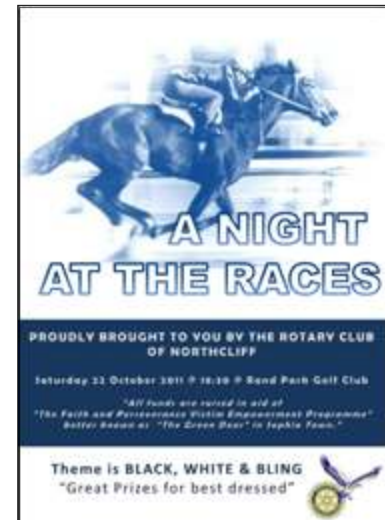
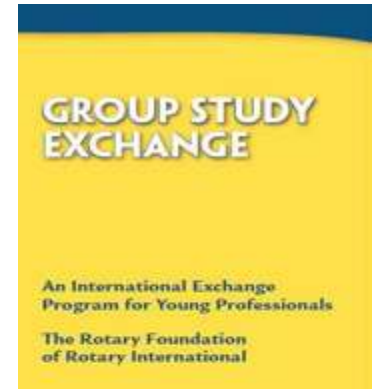
