This week's Rotary Thought is about A strategic partnership with the UNESCO Institute for Water Education.

Rotary and the UNESCO-IHE Institute for Water Education have teamed up to tackle the world's water and sanitation crisis by increasing the ranks of trained professionals critically needed to devise, plan, and implement solutions in developing and emerging countries that bear the brunt of the problem. Through the partnership, the Foundation will offer packaged global grants that Rotary clubs may use to select and sponsor scholarships for professionals in the water sector. Up to eight students a year may be chosen for any of three master of science programs at the institute in Delft, the Netherlands. Details for the packaged global grant are being finalized, and an announcement will be made as soon as the application becomes available online.
